HOW TO USE

Use Dream according to the dilution table below:

AMOUNT OF DREAM TO USE				
Soilage	Toilets	Floor mopping	Waterless urinals	Sinks & troughs
Heavy or Light	50ml/day	1 in 2 1 in 20	50ml + 1L water	50-100ml Neat
Directions	Pour into toilet bowl. Leave all night to work.	Leave for 5 mins. Wipe excess. Do not rinse. Allow to dry. Repeat until odour is gone.	Pour product & water into urinal to activate.	Pour product into outlet pipe at the end of day. Allow to work slowly overnight.

WHERE IT WORKS

Dream is designed for use on porcelain and stainless steel toilet bowls, urinals, vitreous enamel baths and basins, shower recesses, ceramic tiles, stainless steel benches, sinks and troughs. It can be used on all hard surfaces. Dream is a biologically active product and therefore must not be mixed with disinfectants, sanitisers, hot water or strong chemicals as these will deactivate the good bacteria that are present and needed for the product to work.

HOW IT WORKS

Dream is an excellent odour neutraliser that is carefully formulated to contain good bacterial spores that are harmless to humans. When the product is added to water or toilet waste, the bacteria grows and in the process consumes the organic waste matter that is present. This matter then gets broken down into CO₂ and water-soluble molecules and stops the growth of bad-smelling bacteria by removing their food source.

These sheets contain information that you may need to protect your employees and customers against health or safety hazards associated with our product. STORAGE

Dream is stable for 12 months. Store in the original sealed container and keep out of direct sunlight. Avoid storing the product in extreme temperatures – keep it between 10°C-30°C. Use solutions within 6-8 hours of dilution. After this time, they may begin to lose their effectiveness.

DISPOSAL INFORMATION

1. Used solutions

Used solutions of Reflect should be poured into a drain or trough that leads to the sewer system or a septic tank. These systems have a method for treating and breaking down the waste.

Used solutions of detergent should not be poured into stormwater drains or down driveways as these drains are designed for rain water and ultimately lead to the local river system. Although Reflect has a low aquatic toxicity, detergents in general are not good for aquatic wildlife.

2. Unused product

It is best to keep the product and use it up! If this is not possible, try to give it to someone who can use it. (Make sure the product is in its original, labelled container).

If there is no alternative but disposal, it is safe to pour modest quantities of this product down the drain (to sewer) with running water. Leave the cold tap running for a few moments afterwards as this dilutes the product and reduces the concentration in the wastewater. Remember, do not mix different cleaning products together during disposal!

3. Empty packaging

Bottles

Our 5L bottles are made from HDPE (polyethylene) or PET which can be recycled. You can dispose of these containers via the kerbside collection program or other recycling system. Reflect containers will be cleaned and reused if returned to Chemrose Suppliers Pty Ltd., significantly reducing plastic usage and waste.

Cardboard cartons

Our cartons contain a minimum of 70% of recycled cardboard and/or paper. Used boxes should be flattened and recycled in OCC (old corrugated cardboard) or mixed waste paper recycling programs.

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
